MY OFFICE BAR

On January 14, 2007, Vallejo Police Officers responded to a call of shots fired at My Office Bar in the 2400 block of Sacramento Street. Victim Jose Corona was shot by a stray round that went through a front window of the bar; he succumbed to his wound at the scene.

Detectives later learned that there was an argument between several "Family Affiliated Irish Mafia" (FAIM) gang members in front of the bar prior to the shooting. FAIM is a white criminal street gang based out of the city of Rodeo, California. Detectives, with the cooperation of witnesses who were present at the shooting scene, positively identified 29 year-old gang member Joseph Verducci as the shooter and a warrant for his arrest was obtained. Verducci has a last known address in Rodeo.

Verducci was ultimately arrested at San Quentin Prison, where he is in custody for an unrelated offense. His arraignment is scheduled for January 30, 2008, in Department 21 of Solano County Superior Court, Vallejo.
